

Wendell Washes Hands!



Wendell would like to help you teach your children how to wash their hands properly.

(Wendell should know, he has 8 to wash!)

You need a white bowl, water, pepper, and hand soap.

1. Put water in the white bowl.
 2. Sprinkle lots of pepper on the water's surface.
Say, "The pepper on the water is like germs."
 3. Ask your child to poke their left index finger into the center of the bowl. (pepper should stick to the finger)
Say, "These are like germs that are on your hands".
 4. Squirt soap on the child's right index finger.
 5. Ask your child to poke their soapy right index finger into the center of the bowl. (pepper will quickly move away from the soap.)
Say, "This is why we wash our hands. Germs do not like soap, The soap will make the germs wash away!"
